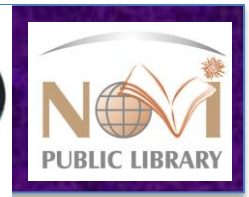
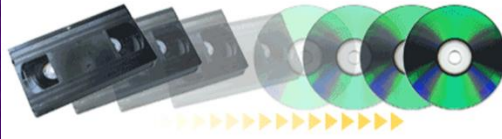



VHS to DVD Direct Dubbing




This combination VCR and DVD recorder will allow archiving of [home movies](#)* from VHS tape to DVD.


This recorder only copies onto **DVD-R** (Minus R).  It can not copy onto DVD+R. Please make sure you have the proper type of DVD.

There is no video editing software on this recorder. If you wish to edit your movie, the Creation Station has the software to do so. Please ask for assistance with the Creation Station.

***Does not copy pre-recorded Hollywood studio movies.**

1. Insert the VHS movie and a blank DVD-R into the recorder.
2. Press the **PLAY**  button on the VCR controls.
3. Press **D. DUBBING** on the front of the recorder to start the transfer. A red **DB** symbol will appear on the display. Do not Fast Forward the tape. The movie is dubbed at normal speed.



4. Press **STOP**  on the VCR when you are done dubbing. The movie will be copied over (written) to the DVD.
5. Press **SETUP** on the remote control. Choose **DVD MENU**. Select **FINALIZE***. This will take anywhere from several minutes up to an hour. Once finalized, no more video can be added.

***IMPORTANT! - If the DVD is not finalized, it will not play on any other machine.**
