Do not seal markers, Monument markers need to breathe Don't clean more than once a year Once every 10 years is sufficient Don't use abrasive pads, don't power wash them

DO LIST

Use Distilled bottled water to clean and rinse the stones Nylon Bristle Brushes

Reading stones:

Use a large mirror, read the reflection Tracing paper and a tennis ball, do a rubbing that way. A rubbing with a crayon can be too abrasive
